PART 4A : Invitation and Terms and Conditions

You are invited to apply for a Catering Stall in Rotary Gardens on Saturday 20th July 2024 as part of the Pilton Green Man Day.

The theme is the medieval period and is centred on the ancient Green Man and Prior ritual. As before, we emphasise the medieval theme and would appreciate it if you would dress up and decorate your stall accordingly. We would especially like sellers of hand-made items, home-made/grown and organic produce, charity stalls, etc. The sale of alcohol will not be permitted. **Pilton Green Man Day wishes to be plastic-friendly so please use bio-degradable plates, cups & cutlery.**

Charges

Small Catering Stalls - £135

Large Catering Stalls - £235

If you are unsure of your stall size, please send details to request charges.

All stall costs are payable in advance (by bank transfer (preferred) or cheque payable to Pilton Green Man CIO). Please send or confirm bank payment and evidence of insurance with the signed **Part 4B** below. Please indicate preferred location but Pilton Green Man Committee's decision on your pitch position is final. Refunds will not be given if cancelled within 6 weeks of Green Man Day.

Terms and Conditions

1. All catering stalls must provide evidence of public liability (PL) insurance and confirm this by ticking the box in **Part 4B** of the form.
2. The safety of Pilton Green Man Day is paramount. Please note that:
 - a. each stallholder is responsible for their actions and for the safety of their stall;
 - b. all portable electrical equipment must have an appropriate up-to-date Portable Appliance Test (PAT) and supplies from households should be protected by a 30milliamp residual current device;
 - c. all gas equipment must have an appropriate up-to-date safety certificate (see Note below);
 - d. where fire extinguishers are required, staff should be familiar with their use.
3. The Pilton Green Man Committee accepts no liability for loss or damage or any claim arising from the stallholders actions or produce and reserves the right to refuse a stall if considered unsafe or inappropriate, including on the day. It reserves the right to inspect and demand disconnection of gas or electrical equipment if it is considered not to meet the full safety requirements.
4. No tables or gazebos are available for stall holders. Please bring your own.
5. All Catering Stalls must comply with relevant food hygiene & safety regulations, supply their own rubbish bins & remove all rubbish at the end of the day. A charge may be made by the Pilton Green Man Day Committee if rubbish is not removed.
6. Access to Rotary Gardens for set-up is permitted only from the North Road entrance opposite the Fire Station. All vehicular movements in Rotary Gardens must be completed and the vehicles removed by 9.45am. For public safety reasons, there is no vehicular exit from Rotary Gardens before 5pm. There is plenty of parking locally.
